GOAL: To achieve mutual understanding between both parties

COLLEGE PANHELLENIC VIOLATION REPORT

- » Filed within 30 days of alleged infraction
- » Infraction Notice then completed by Panhellenic president
- » Infraction Notice distributed to accused, FSA and NPC area advisor

MEDIATION



GOAL: To find a satisfactory solution for both parties

the mediator

- Unbiased third party
- Not the FSA

INVOLVED PARTIES COME TO A RESOLUTION

JUDICIAL BOARD HEARING



DO NOT REACH AGREEMENT

REACH AGREEMENT

judicial board

- Composition established in bylaws
- Includes a chairman and vice chairman
- FSA serves as ex-officio member

SANCTIONS

- » Should fit the nature and degree of the offense
- » Can only be monetary fines when predetermined in governing documents for a measurable offense
- » Cannot exceed one calendar year



APPEALS

- » Can be filed by any party involved in the judicial board hearing
- » Can reverse or uphold the judicial board decision
- » Paperwork — Appeal Notice — must be filed within seven days of hearing
